Please find our Summer Reading Packet including book names and book reports attached, by grade level. All book reports are due on Monday, September 12, 2016.

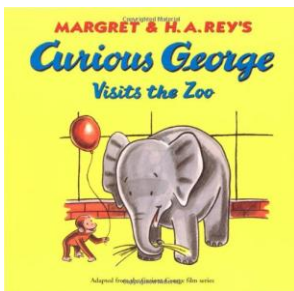
